

# eReaders & Using eMedia from the Library

## Explore your options...

You can check out and download these formats if available:

- Adobe® EPUB eBooks
- Adobe® PDF eBooks
- Kindle® eBooks
- OverDrive WMA Audiobooks
- OverDrive MP3 Audiobooks
- OverDrive Music
- OverDrive Video

To use these you need...

- A valid library card
- Internet access
- For eReaders (not a tablet) a computer.
- Free software for the computer (available at <http://ebooks.lvccld.org>) or if using a tablet or mobile device you will need to install the free OverDrive app (Available in your app store!)



## Getting Started:

Go to MyHelp! at <http://ebooks.lvccld.org> (**eMedia Catalog**) (look for the icon (pictured here) located on left sidebar of the eMedia Catalog.)



- Select the format you want to use i.e. eBooks, eAudio Books, etc.
- Select the type of eReader or tablet or mobile device or computer you want to use to with the format you have selected.

**Step 1 – Check Requirements** - Confirm your computer or mobile device meets the requirements for software (such as *Windows Media® Player, iTunes, etc.*), operating system, and etc. needed for your format.

**Step 2 – Get the Software** - Download and install the free software recommended for your format and device. (Kindle users skip to Step 4 below)

### Step 3 - Activate the Software –

- **eReaders** (except for Kindle) require Adobe **Digital Editions**.

How to activate **Adobe Digital Editions** (ADE):

You can use ADE either anonymously, or with an Adobe ID. If you use ADE anonymously, you can only download and read library eBooks on a single computer. If you use an Adobe ID, you can download and read library eBooks on multiple computers, *and* transfer the eBooks to supported eBook readers (like Sony Reader or Nook). **Recommendation: Get an Adobe ID.** It uses your email address and any password you select. You can use it when you go to the kids' house for the holidays on their computer! - **For tablets and mobile devices** you will need to activate the OverDrive app, just follow the steps in the app for your device.

With software installed you are now ready to find books to checkout! On to Step 4.

#### Step 4 - Check out, download, and enjoy

1. Browse or search the library's downloadable catalog (eMedia Catalog at <http://ebooks.lvccld.org>). When you find a title you want, add it to the **eMedia Bag**, and then Proceed to checkout.
2. For **eReader users or WMA audio users** (not Kindle users) once it's checked out connect your device to the computer.
3. Next, you'll see a "Download Page". Click **Download (Kindle users click Get for Kindle)** to start the process.
4. Once downloading is complete:
  - a. **eReader Users:** Transfer your ebook to your eReader by dragging the book cover to the small icon of your eReader on the sidebar of Adobe Digital Editions.
  - b. **Kindle users:** You will need to use WiFi (not 3G) to sync your ebook with your Kindle from your Amazon account.
  - c. **WMA eAudio users:** Click the **Transfer icon** in OverDrive Media Console.

Once the transferring is complete, open and enjoy your book! You'll never have late fees with eMedia. At the end of the loan period, titles will automatically "go back" to the library. Then you just delete the expired file from your computer. eBooks can be returned early.

#### Explore your options...



The "Advanced Search" page lets you search for a specific genre and a specific eMedia type. Tip: select your format (ePUB or PDF or Kindle) & check off **Only available titles** to download a title immediately.

#### LEAP – Library eBook Accessibility Program

More than 70,000 popular digital books, textbooks, newspapers & magazines are available to print-disabled patrons at no charge. Formats such as DAISY can be used with a variety of devices. Desktop software is also available including Outloud and Victor Reader. To get started visit your library's OverDrive website and apply for a free membership.

#### Freegal – What's free and legal?

Freegal is available to library patrons with a library card and PIN. You get to select up to 3 songs weekly to download and keep them forever! Burn them to a CD or transfer to a MP3 player or iPod.
