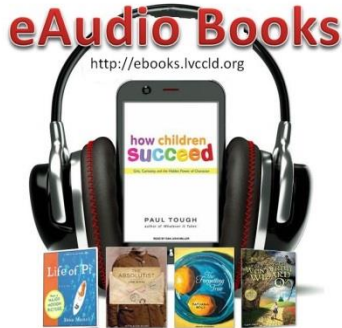


# eAudio Books - Getting started with an iPod

If you have an iPod touch, please follow the instructions in [Getting started with an iOS device \(iPhone/iPad/iPod touch\)](#). For all other models, the guide below will help you get started.



## What you need

- An iPod cable to plug into your computer
- [OverDrive Media Console for Windows](#) or [Mac](#)
- A library card

## How it works

### 1. Install software

Install [OverDrive Media Console](#) (OMC) on your computer to transfer MP3 or WMA audio files to your device.

***Note:** Not all WMA audio titles are available to transfer to an iPod due to publisher agreements. A Windows computer is required to transfer WMA titles.*

### 2. Borrow titles using your computer

First, open your library's digital collection website <http://ebooks.lvccld.org>

Next, [borrow an audio title using your computer](#).

### 3. Transfer titles to your iPod and enjoy

Windows users can transfer **MP3 and compatible WMA audiobooks**

Mac users can transfer **MP3 audiobooks**.

Once you have transferred a title onto your iPod, you can listen to it just like you would any audio file on the device. WMA titles will be listed with your **playlists**, and MP3 titles can be found under '**Music**.'
